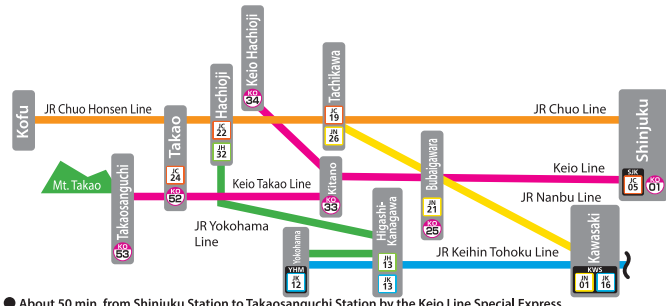

Mt. Takao is only 50 km away from central Tokyo, but it is a treasure trove of flora and fauna where you can experience the diversity of nature.

The wide range of seven different hiking trails, equipped with cable cars and Lift, can be enjoyed by both young and old, men and women alike.

Whenever you visit, you will enjoy the changing landscapes, from cherry blossoms to fresh green leaves to autumn foliage.

Rules to enjoy Mt. Takao

- Plan ahead and be well prepared.
- Take your garbage back with you.
- Stay on the trails.
- Respect the flora and fauna.
- Practice fire safety.
- Help keep toilets and other public facilities clean.
- Keep pets on a leash.
- Don't ride mountain bikes or other wheeled vehicles.
- Don't feed the wildlife.
- Refrain from using drones.

Around Kiyotaki Station

This inset map shows the area around Kiyotaki Station, highlighting the connections between various trails and local landmarks. Key features include:

- Trails:** Trail No. 1 (red), Trail No. 6 (purple), and Inariyama Trail (brown).
- Stations:** Kiyotaki Station, Sanroku Station, and Takaosanguchi Station.
- Landmarks:** Kiyotaki Falls, Fudoin Temple, Takao Forest Fureai Suishin Center, Takao 599 Museum, Takao-Shinbashi Bridge, Takao Bridge, Nishi-Hikawa Bridge, and Hikawa Bridge.
- Other Points:** Momiji Hiroba, Kiyotaki Falls, and various numbered points of interest (e.g., 1-34).

Using the cable car

Takaosan Station to Yakuo-in	1.0 km	About 20 min.
Yakuo-in to the Top of Mt. Takao	0.8 km	About 20 min.

The main map of Mt. Takao provides a comprehensive overview of the mountain's hiking trails and facilities. Key features include:

- Trails:** Six distinct trails are shown, each color-coded and numbered (Trail No. 1 to 6).
- Landmarks:** Notable sites such as the Top of Mt. Takao (100 Famous Views of Mt. Fuji in Kanto Region), Yakuo-in Temple, Miyama Bridge, Large Cedar Trees, and various falls (Jataki Falls, Furutaki Falls, Biwataki Falls).
- Transportation:** Routes for the cable car (Takaosan Station to Yakuo-in), lift (Yakuo-in to Top of Mt. Takao), and bus services (Hikage Bus stop, Jatakiguchi Bus stop).
- Other Points of Interest:** Takao Visitor Center, Stepping stones, Onna-zaka, Stupa, Otoko-zaka, 108-Step stairs, Joshinmon, Takosugi (Octopus-shaped Cedar), Monkey Park, Wild Plant Garden, and various bridges (Oyama Bridge, Myo-on Bridge, Takao Bridge).
- Geography:** The map shows the mountain's location relative to surrounding areas like Kobotoke, Kiyotaki, and Takaosan, as well as the Annai River and Koshu-kaido Road (National Route 20).
