






Place to enjoy

Otsuki City boasts rich nature with the most beautiful view of Mt. Fuji in Japan. A roughly 1-hour trip by limited express train takes you to this city. The city has many historical and legendary sites, whose names are associated with the old tale of Momotaro. Among them are Koshu Kaido street. Iwadono Castle ruins, and Saruhashi bridge.





Obarajuku Honjin 🍣



Honiin refers to an inn where feudal lords in the Edo Period (alternate attendance). Obarajuku Honjin is the only remaining one of 26 honjin's that existed in Kanagawa Prefecture. It is a valuable building that was designated an important cultural



Head Temple Takao-san Yakuouin is an old Buddhist temple that was established in 744. It has long been known as a place for ascetic training. This temple serves shojin-ryori, or Buddhist vegetarian dishes for mountain priests. Why not drop by to experience the history and culture of Japan? ** *Reservation is required for Shojin-ryori, in principle.
